

PULASKI YOUTH ORGANIZATION Boys' Tournament Rules and Reminders

1. Awards – T-shirts will be awarded to all pool winners (12/team). You may bring more on your team, but only 12 awards are given per team. Wild card teams are not pool winners. In addition, the first and second place finishers in the overall playoffs for each grade will receive individual trophies (12 per team).
2. Balls will not be provided for warm-ups:
3rd - 6th grade: 28.5” basketballs.
7th – 8th grade: Men’s basketballs.
3. Be early- Arrive at game site at least one-half hour before each game. Deliver your roster to scorer's table in advance of each game.
4. Each team is numbered – Lower numbered team in each pool will be home team.
5. An adult must provide supervision at all times in any area of Pulaski schools. You and your team will be responsible for any damage! Any destruction of property will result in disqualification.
6. No shooting during half time or between games by anyone not involved in the game in progress.
7. Each player should wear a numbered uniform.
8. Timing:
3rd -6th grade: 18 minute halves with running clock until the final two minutes of the halves, with the clock stopping per WIAA rules.
7th and 8th grade: Two 14-minute halves. Clock will stop as per WIAA rules.
9. The three-point rule is in effect for all games
10. Warm-ups will be 5-10 minutes. Half time will be 5 minutes. These times may be adjusted slightly to remain on schedule.
11. Scorers and timers: Each team must provide an official scorer or timer for the games.
12. Overtime- A three-minute overtime period with running clock the first two minutes and stopping at each whistle the final minute.
13. Technical fouls will be not be shot. Two points and the ball for player and bench technical fouls.

14. Profanity will not be tolerated! A double technical may be assessed and possible ejection. Four points and the ball will be awarded.
15. Pressing is allowed at any time. No press allowed though if up by 20 or more points. No pressing in 3rd through 6th grade except last two minutes of each half.
16. Defense: 3rd - 6th grade only man to man. Man to man defense can split the floor, but cannot have more defenders than offensive players on the strong side. 7th - 8th grade can play any type of defense.
17. Timeouts - Four-30 seconds timeouts per game – No carryovers. One additional per overtime period.
18. Coaches may stand in coach's box during play.
- 19. Referee and/or tournament directors without appeal will settle all disputes.**
20. Waiver or release: The Pulaski Community School District, the Pulaski Youth Organization, the Management of this Tournament, or any Team Manager shall not be held responsible for personal injury to any player or person or loss of team or individual property during this Tournament.
